RE: 76th FIP CONGRESS – NOMINATIONS TO THE FIP BOARD OF DIRECTORS & COMMISSIONS BUREAUX

Dear Madam, dear Sir,

With reference to the letter sent on behalf of the FIP Board on 22 April 2021 to all Members, the 76th FIP Congress was planned on **9 August, 2022**, in Jakarta, Indonesia, immediately after the INDONESIA 2022 World Stamp Exhibition to be held from 4 - 9 August 2022.

Please be informed that after consultation with the FIP legal advisor, the current FIP Board has decided during the 140th FIP Conference meeting, held on 15 November 2021, that every position of the FIP Board of Directors will be re-elected during the 76th FIP Congress in 2022:

- **Vice-Presidents and Directors of Americas and Europe will be elected for 2022-2024**
- **President, Vice-President and Director of Asia will be elected for 2022-2026**

This is to ensure that the ordinary intervals and terms of office can be correctly observed again as soon as possible, from the 77th Congress onwards.

As previously advised by the FIP legal advisor:

“...the motions and candidacies submitted for the August 11, 2020 and the November 10, 2020 Congress must remain valid and must be put before the Congress for discussion.”

Hence, it is **not required to re-submit the nomination form(s)** if there had been candidate(s) from your Federation who remain unchanged in 2022 for:

- i) Vice-President for the Americas;
- ii) Director for the Americas;
- iii) Vice-President for Europe;
- iv) Director for Europe;
- v) FIP Commission's Bureaux

However, please note that the term of the elected Vice-Presidents and Directors of the Americas and Europe will now be two years from 2022-2024. The Commission's Bureaux will be elected for 2022-2026.
